Minutes of Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2025

George Walker mentioned that access to the village was recently severely compromised by major repairs to a water main in One Pin Lane which closed it for many days, and a simultaneous and horrendous snarl up of at least 12 cars each way in the Narrows. He suggested the Narrows needed to be widened to two lanes for village safety. TB said that he had never heard the suggestion before but would think about it.

Rainer Struck said that 40 people had been at the Litter Pick and 50 Members of Tracy Trust lunch. Concern was made regarding overhanging branches on Hedgerley Hill. TB said that the Electricity company had a team which came out specifically to deal with this.

JDL asked that block work will be reinstated with the original after City Fibre had completed their task.

JDL said he had a copy of the Farnhams magazine and read about CIL money. He wondered if there was an opportunity for money available for Hedgerley. TB explained that CIL was only available when a substantial development was undertaken.
