Minutes of Meeting held on 9th OCTOBER, 2025

1. To approve Minutes

Minutes were approved as a true record, and signed.

COMMUNITY SUBMISSIONS

Rainer Struck asked if there would be any objection to holding carol singing near the bus stop and where would it be possible to have an extension lead.

He also asked if it were possible to have a cross-roads at the One Pin junction. TB said we would be requesting STOP signs instead of Give Way signs. FCPC Chairman would be happy to talk about this.

TB also asked PH to arrange reinstalling the MVAS

Mention was also made of his finding a box on Hedgerley Hill which contained used nitrous canisters.

George Walker asked if it was possible to have a shovel in each of the salt bins. PH told him that when we first provided shovels, they all got taken. TB said people have to bring their own.

George was also concerned about the condition of the two cherry trees by the bus stop. Ben has inspected and advised removal. PH to contact our new Highways chap (Chris) to find out the ownership of this area.

2. Bucks Council

TB said that new gritting lorries have been provided. They are bright orange. Also Ingrebourne have promised to salt along the Drag Strip. Structural repairs are due in March/April on Hedgerley Hill.

3. Clerk's information items

Referring to the mention by Rainer of finding a box with used nitrous canisters. A 'den' was found in Kemsley Wood with used canisters and yellow balloons. Also a camouflage netting was with it. This has all been removed by HPC.
