Minutes of Meeting held on 20th NOVEMBER, 2025

8.00pm Memorial Hall, Hedgerley

Chairman indicated emergency exits

1. To approve Minutes

Minutes were approved as a true record, and signed.

Community Submissions

JL asked if the brushwood behind the fencing in Coppice Way be chipped and cleared.

Reiner was told it wouldn't be possible to string a cable across the road to light the Christmas tree for the proposed carol signing

He was also concerned about the work being done in the field along Hedgerley Hill. He was told it was repairs to the gas main.

He also mentioned there had been another accident at the One Pin cross roads. TB said he was going to try and get the 'give way' sign changed to a 'stop' sign and also said that the MVA's would make a difference.

Maurice Ridgeley concerned about the puddle at the bottom of Stevenson Road. Although Affinity have over several years done work on it, the problem keeps recurring. They are unsure where the water is coming from.

NC regarding the Bioersivity plan, Harriet Lally, the new Church Warden, is keen to work on the Church Yard.

Further on from the rumour that the RSPB sanctuary was going to be sold, this has not proved to be true.
