Bucks Council budget – TW said they are looking at the budget. The Fair Funding review will have 50/60 million pounds taken out of the budget and given to other councils. We will no longer be able to provide certain things because of this. The Budget will be finalised in January 2026. We are trying to protect current jobs and have managed to save certain services.
